

Land Wanted

To enable the Club to hold local events we are always looking out for land that can be used to hold a “Motorcycle Trial” event on, within a 25-mile radius of Southampton.

A Motorcycle Trial is a test of balance and control, in which a motorcycle is ridden through several “observed sections” which include obstacles such as fallen trees, mud, rocks and hills. The course is marked out using small coloured “flags” that are placed into the ground.

The land we use can be anything but flat! Disused pits, quarries, hillsides, embankments, and woods with fallen trees are all good for us. The rougher the better!

We typically have about 50-60 riders at each event. Parking is required for their vehicles in an adjacent field or yard that has road access. We have no paying spectators.

Our events will cause no lasting damage to the land, is noise controlled, fully insured and regulated by The Auto Cycle Union, the sport’s governing body.

We pay owners for the use of land or make a donation to a nominated charity.
